- Have a disability
- Have passed preferably Grade 12 or equivalent (Grade 11 may be considered)
- Be between the ages of 18 and 40
- Reside in the Vaal, areas in and around Johannesburg, areas in and around Pretoria, areas in and around Durban, Port Elizabeth, Bloemfontein and Cape Town
- Be unemployed and NOT be participating in a current learnership
- Be able to travel independently to the training centre and workplace
- Be willing to undergo the assessment process before selection
- Be willing undergo an MIE / ITC credit check
- Be a South African citizen
